

**Yard Waste Collection**  
**Conewago Twp. (Adams Co.)**  
**May 13, 2017**

**Who:** Single Family Residences

**What:** Brush, Sticks & Leaves

**How:** Yard Waste will be collected curbside and should be placed out the evening prior to May 13, 2017. All yard waste shall be placed in Kraft bio-degradable bags, trash bins or tied in bundles.

**Not Collected:** Plastic bags, loose plant materials, and grass.

Conewago Township residents must have an active service account with Waste Management (1-800-433-7317) for collection.

Kraft bio-degradable (or equivalent) bags can be purchased at home supply stores.

Essential to Consider....

Conewago Township cares for the future of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's streams and waterways, the Chesapeake Bay and also the stormwater management infrastructure of our municipality.

However, we cannot do it alone, so we ask for our local property owners, residents and businesses to refrain from discharging grass and vegetation from lawn mowers and string trimmers onto the streets and into the gutters while you are maintaining your yards.

The discharged clippings are washed into the stormwater collection systems and can clog both inlet boxes and pipes causing localized flooding. The clippings are also considered an organic pollutant in the waterways and as such, they threaten the health of our waterways, both locally and watershed wide.

Stormwater collection drains are for the collection of stormwater runoff only. We respectfully ask that you NOT discard or dump detergents, paints, oils, and other chemicals and caustic substances into the drains.
